SPRAY APPLICATION

Use sufficient spray volume to ensure good cover of the crop with penetration of the spray into the middle of the trees and bushes as appropriate. Apply to dry foliage when rain is not forecast.

SPRAY MIXING

Shake the product container thoroughly before opening. Three-quarters fill the spray tank with clean water and put under agitation. Mix in the required volume of Clayton Scabius through the top filter or filling device. Top up the tank with water and keep under agitation until sprayed out. When co-applying compatible products, add each separately to the spray tank, mixing Clayton Scabius in the spray tank first unless directed otherwise.
